February 8th, 2026 check in starts @ 9:00 A.M.

The Broward County USBC Association will guarantee \$3,000.00 in scholarship (1st - \$600.00, 2nd - \$400.00, 3rd - \$300.00 & 4th - \$200.00 and \$50.00 for high game in each division for each squad.)

Divisions: Scratch (190 average and above) and Handicap. You can only choose one division. A bowler may choose to move up a division (handicap to scratch) however, no bowler will be permitted to move down a division.

Format: Bowl three (3) games on one (1) pair of lanes. After the three (3) game block, 4 bowlers (highest total pins) in each division in will advance to the stepladder roll-offs. All ties (to determine top two (2) or in the rolls-offs) will be broken by a 9th & 10th frame roll off until the tie is broken. **Two practice balls on each lane for the roll-offs.**

All bowlers must be a current USBC member in good standing.

Handicap: Division is based on 100% of 210

Average for Tournament: Highest 2025-2026 average of 21 games or more.

Tournament director will approve any score corrections or appoint a delegate Tournament worker, verify all foul lights will be in working order and used. Tournament Director has the right to rerate any bowler.

All entry fees: \$30.00 per bowler will be charged for pre-registration and **\$40.00 for walk-ins.** The extra \$10.00 charge for walk-ins will be added to the prize fund. The prize fund is returned 100%. There are no administrative fees for this tournament, all paper, computers, ribbons, etc. is donated. Returned check fee is \$35.00 for any returned checks. Breakdown of fee:

Pre-registration if received by February 5th, 2026
\$30.00 Entry Fee \$13.50 Lineage \$16.50 Prize Fund

Entry received **after** February 5th, 2026
\$40.00 Entry Fee \$11.25 Lineage \$26.50 Prize Fund

Wearing Apparel: All bowlers must wear suitable attire throughout the tournament. No halters, tank tops, spaghetti straps or head apparel. Earbuds cannot be worn on the approach. Shorts, skorts or skirts MUST fingertip length. All pants must be worn at waist level with no underwear or bare skin showing. Holes (torn or purchased) in clothing are not allowed. Youth participants will not wear or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance, or inappropriate language/gestures during competition (rule 301b). Tournament Officials will determine proper attire. Tournament Director has the right to ask any bowler to change their clothing or equipment. If the bowler refuses, he or she will NOT be permitted to bowl, and the entry fee will be forfeited. Cell phone usage is not permitted except for a scoring app and may result in disqualification. Bowling shoes must be worn by participants, no street shoes will be allowed. In accordance with USBC rules and Florida Statutes, no alcohol products can be consumed or used on the concourse, where the tournament is bowling. No substance of any kind may be placed on score tables or ball returns, only dry towels, and pads. USBC approved ball cleaners may only be used prior to beginning participation in this tournament.

Conduct: Any bowler hitting, kicking, slapping out, defacing bowling property or equipment, using foul language intentional squeaking of shoes, or using offensive gestures and general bad sportsmanship will be removed from the tournament. No playing of video games or games allowed while in tournament competition. Bowler will be removed from the tournament by the tournament director and no refunds will be given. **USBC Code of Ethics and Tournament Rules will prevail and be enforced.**
