WOMEN'S COUNTY TOURNAMENT RULES 2026
THIS TOURNAMENT WILL BE IN STRICT ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF USBC

1. Entering Averages: Entrants entering average will be the highest 2024-2025 winter of 21 games or more on bowl.com; if no winter than a 2024-2025 summer average of 21 games or more will be accepted. If none of these apply, then your current average of 21 games will be used. (Proof of average must be presented either at the tournament site or sent in with entries.) All other will be scratch. THE 10-PIN RULE ON JANUARY 1ST AVERAGES HAS BEEN WAIVED. If your tournament average is left-handed, you must bowl left-handed. If it is right-handed, you must bowl right-handed
2. Handicap: Handicap will be figured at 90% of the individual average of 220.
3. Doubles/Singles: Bowlers entered in the doubles event must also bowl in the singles event. Bowlers entered in the singles event must also bowl in doubles event. Doubles will be bowled prior to singles. Doubles and singles may be bowled without bowling team event. In order to enter the HDCP Senior singles, you must be 50 or older on the day of the tournament.
4. All Events: All events are optional and are handicapped and scratch. An additional \$5.00 must accompany the entry form and the All-Events prize fund will be returned 100%.
5. Substitutes: All substitutes should be made one hour before the scheduled time to bowl. The substitute once started remains to complete the event. A substitute must take the place of the absent entrant and will receive the prize money for the event(s) bowled. No pacers will be allowed. To qualify for all-events, substitutes must sub for the same individual throughout the tournament events.
6. Tardy Bowlers: Any bowler arriving after a scheduled event has started will be permitted to bowl unless a substitute has started. Her score will count beginning with the frame bowled. No score will be given for the missed frames
Bowlers are permitted to leave the bowling circle, however if not present when they are up to bowl, tournament director reserve the right to give zeros when deemed necessary.
7. Order of Bowling: All three games in each event are to be bowled on the pair of lanes assigned, unless an emergency arises Entrants must bowl in the order in which their names appear on the entry application. Be ready to bowl when it is your turn, even if you are alone on a pair of lanes.
8. Protests: Any protest affecting eligibility, playing rules or errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Director within 24 hours. Print out of scores from the center will be official. All games rolled with an illegal bowling ball will be disqualified. Limit one ball per bowler on the ball return. Tournament officials and bowlers are allowed in the bowling circles only.
9. Disqualifications: No entry fee will be refunded if disqualification occurs.
10. Questions: Any questions not covered by these rules will be deferred to USBC and will be handled by the Tournament Director.
11. Attire: Proper attire is required. No halters or tank tops will be allowed. Shorts, skirts or skorts must be longer than your fingertips when placed by your side. All pants will be worn at waist level with no underwear or bare skin showing. Tournament officials will determine proper attire. Bowlers are NOT permitted to wear headphones. No speakers will be allowed during competition. Bowlers may wear one air-pod during competition.
12. Check-In: Bowlers must check-in one hour prior to bowling with their 2025-2026 USBC membership cards. If you cannot find your bowling card, please go to bowl.com and print one.
13. Rule 18 – Bowling Ball - Altering Surface While bowling in USBC competition, a bowling ball cannot: a. Have the surface altered by the use of an abrasive. b. Be cleaned with any liquid substance or cleaning agent. c. Have any foreign material on it including, but not limited to, powder, rosin, marker or paint. All bowling balls so altered or cleaned must be removed from the competition.
