Adult & Youth Combined averages

Division 1 – 300 & Above

Division 2 – 299 & Below

HANDICAP 100% OF 230

The Adult/Junior Doubles Scholarship Tournament will be certified by USBC and open to all current certified bowlers.

Entry fees will be \$25.00—Per Bowler \$14.00 Lineage, \$11.00 Scholarship, Early entry deadline is Wednesday October 1, 2025 . Late entries will be accepted at \$30.00 per bowler. Walk-ins will be accepted. (Cash only)

Prize fund is returned 100% in scholarship funds, based on the number of entries per division and will be deposited with SMART #9906. Adult scores will be added to Youth scores and total prize funds will be posted to youth bowler's SMART account.

Averages will be based on bowl.com averages highest book average of 2025, of 15 games will be used. Adult and Junior bowlers will bowl three (3) games on the same pair of lanes. The three games total plus handicap will determine winners. In the case of a first-place tie, there will be a one game roll-off to determine tournament champion.

NOTE:

Proper attire is required. No one will be permitted to bowl wearing any apparel or use any equipment with alcohol or tobacco advertising or suggestive, obscene lettering or pictures.

No midribs or tank tops will be allowed. Knee length shorts and jeans will be allowed. Bowling shoes must be worn – no street shoes allowed. Only bowlers and tournament workers are allowed in the bowling circle. Also, hats, headphones, or cell phones are not allowed in the bowling circle.

Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Abuse or misuse of bowling center, your personal equipment, fellow's equipment, abusive and/or profane language or gestures, by a bowler or spectator, will not be tolerated at any time while in the bowling center.

All bowlers must be on their assigned lane and ready to bowl when it is their turn to bowl. **No outside food is permitted.** Alcohol is not permitted while bowling in this tournament.

Any discrepancies must be brought to the attention of a tournament official. The decision of the tournament committee is final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329. All rules not covered will be governed by USBC rules. Failure to abide by these rules and regulations is subject to disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees.
